The number restrictions are to be followed as per university guidelines.

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council (List of the Boards/Councils are given below) in the year 2022/2021/2020 are eligible to apply for B.A. General courses with subjects:01. Bengali; 02.English; 03.Sanskrit; 04.Philosophy; 05. Political Science; and B.Sc. General courses with subjects: 06. Economics; 07.Geography; 08.Physics; 09.Chemistry; 10. Mathematics, provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (as applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject.

Candidates passed **Vocational Courses** can apply in General Courses only.

A candidate passing 10+2 level before 2 (two) years from present academic year with above mentioned criteria can also apply after getting special permission from the Secretary, U.G. Council Vidyasagar University, Midnapore.

It is also mentioned that the admission will be treated as provisional unless or until the candidate is registered to Vidyasagar University through this college. Any suppression of facts, found in future, will cancel the admission.
