Celebration of Independence Day, 15th August, 2022

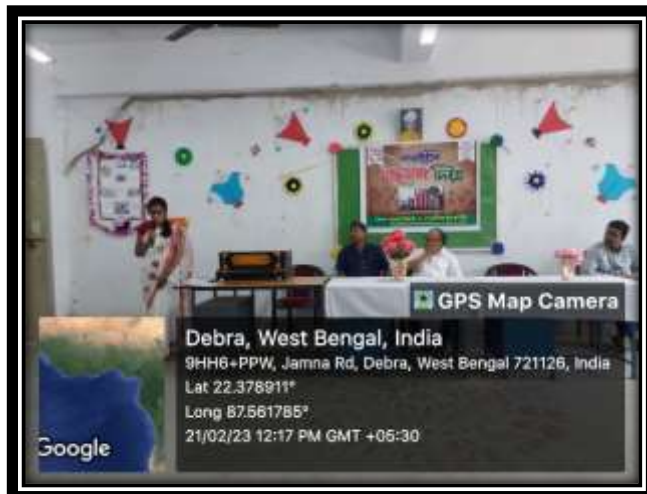
