Eligibility Criteria

Eligibility criteria for admission in 4 year B.S./B.A./B.Sc (Hons.) with one major.

Candidates qualifying Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council (List of the Boards/Councils is given below) in the year 2023/2022/2021 are eligible for apply for B.A. Major courses in: **01. Bengali; 02.English; 03.Sanskrit; 04.Philosophy; 05. Political Science;**and B.Sc. Major courses in: **06. Economics; 07.Geography; 08.Geology; 09.Physics; 10.Chemistry; 11. Mathematics,** provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (as applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject. The number restrictions are to be followed as per university guidelines.

The following table shows the subjects or allied subjects required for admission and grade point calculation in Honours Courses:

Bengali	Bengali.	10% of the total marks of best five subjects+ Marks of Bengali.
English	English.	10% of the total marks of best five subjects + Marks of English.
Sanskrit	Bengali or Sanskrit.	10% of the total marks of best five subjects + Highest Marks between Bengali and Sanskrit.
Political Science	Bengali or Political Science.	10% of the total marks of best five subjects + Highest Marks between Bengali and Political Science.
Philosophy	Bengali or Philosophy.	10% of the total marks of best five subjects + Highest Marks between Bengali and Philosophy.
Economics	Mathematics or Economics.	10% of the total marks of best five subjects + Highest Marks between Mathematics and Economics.
Geography	Geography or Mathematics.	10% of the total marks of best five subjects + Highest Marks between Geography and Mathematics.
Geology	Mathematics,Physics,Chemistry	10% of the total marks of best five subjects + Marks of Mathematics.
Mathematics	Mathematics.	10% of the total marks of best five subjects + Marks of Mathematics.
Physics	Physics.	10% of the total marks of best five subjects+ Marks of Physics.
Chemistry	Chemistry.	10% of the total marks of best five subjects+ Marks of Chemistry.

Eligibility criteria for admission in 3 year multidisciplinary courses.

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council (List of the Boards/Councils are given below) in the year 2023/2022/2021 are eligible to apply for multidisciplinary courses :**01. Multidisciplinary studies in physical sciences 02. Multidisciplinary studies in social sciences 03. Multidisciplinary studies in humanities**, provided that the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (as applicable) recognized subjects including at least one language subject.

Candidates passed **Vocational Courses** can apply in 3 year multidisciplinary Courses only.

A candidate passing **10+2 level before 2 (two) years from present** academic year with above mentioned criteria can also apply after getting special permission from the Secretary, U.G. Council Vidyasagar University, Midnapore.

It is also mentioned that the admission will be treated as provisional unless or until the candidate is registered to Vidyasagar University through this college. Any suppression of facts, found in future, will cancel the admission.

Merit Point Calculation

Admission will be done on merit basis. Merit point for admission in Honours courses is will be calculated by adding 10% of total marks obtained in the best five subjects excluding Environmental Studies at Higher Secondary/equivalent examination and the marks obtained in the subject or related subject in which the admission in Honours course is sought. See eligibility criteria for details.

The merit points for admission to General courses are to be calculated by adding the marks obtained in best five subjects excluding Environmental Studies of H.S. / equivalent examination.

#Note: If more candidates score same merit point, preference will be given to the one who has scored higher marks in the subject, in this way, if more candidates have same merit points and same marks in the subject; preference will be given to the candidate who has scored higher marks in 1st Language/ 2nd Language. If more candidates have same merit points, same marks in the subject and same marks in in 1st Language/ 2nd Language preference will be given to the candidate who has scored higher marks in the 10 level (Madhyamik/ ICSE/CBSE etc.) examination.
