

SUGGESTIONS/RECOMMENDATIONS RECEIVED THROUGH THE FEEDBACK FROM STUDENTS FOR THE SESSION 2020-21

Some observations/suggestions from students are mainly to improve the overall teaching-learning experience in the institution. The analysis of overall feedback of the students show that majority of students are satisfied with overall performance of the institution. The following areas in the feedback are indicative for improvement.

- Infrastructural facilities should be improved focusing on class rooms, laboratories and library.
- More interactions with Parents.
- Assistance for more scholarship facility.
- Cleanliness of toilet in college.

ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON STUDENT FEEDBACK: 2020-21

In the academic session, feedback was obtained through Google form. Total 348 feedback was received from the students. The feedback received from the students has reviewed thoroughly. On the basis, of the feedback received, the following actions have been taken, keeping in mind the needs and interests of the stakeholders. The detailed analysis and suggestions were placed in the online IQAC meeting dated 19.07.2021, for appraisal and suggestions of members and for further action. The analysis of overall feedback of the students show that majority of students are satisfied with overall performance of the institution.

Some students suggested improvement of infrastructural facilities; in view of the prolonged impact of the pandemic effect over the academic ecosystem, the college authority has taken-up measures towards proper upkeep and maintenance of classrooms, laboratories, canteen and other renovations.

Parent-teacher meetings are an essential component of a student's education and that provide opportunity for parents/guardians and teachers to discuss the students' academic progress, social development, and overall performance in college. Once the post covid normalcy will be fully restored, parents and teachers' interactions will be arranged to share specific guidelines about usage of ICT enable handheld devices/smart phones that students need to adhere back home.

Proper arrangement has been made for informed assistance regarding scholarship so students can avail of all such financial assistance from respective authorities. Furthermore, the inputs collected were taken into consideration to improve the overall learning experience for students introducing more ICT based tools for teaching and learning. Restoration of services and routine maintenance including toilets will be taken-up once off-line classes will be resumed.



In the academic session, feedback was obtained through Google form. Total 24 feedback was received from the Teachers/faculties of the college.

The detailed analysis and suggestions were placed in the online IQAC meeting dated 19.07.2021, for appraisal and suggestions of members and for further action.

Based on the analysed report, the following points were discussed for actions to be taken: Regarding syllabus related issues the members were unanimous in their decision to initiate frequent remedial and mentoring classes for the students to discuss more specifically about the programme outcome and course outcome.

Regarding accessibility to more reference materials, in the current covid outbreak scenario the members suggested to enhance scope for more e-Resources and encourage students as well teachers to make use of college ILMS platform and teachers are to contribute more e-Resource.

Owing to prolong covid related outbreak the members agreed to take necessary measures towards restoration of all services, cleanliness in classrooms, campus and maintenance of laboratories.
