Today was the sixth day of the discussion series titled 'Bengali Literature: A Multidimensional Review' organized jointly by the Bengali Department of Shahid Matangini Hazra Government General Degree College for Women and IQAC. Professor and researcher Debapriya Bhattacharya was present among us today. The topic of his speech was : ''Rabindra Kobita Kikore Porbo.'' All Bengali children are introduced to Rabindranath's poetry from their very childhood. But Rabindranath Tagore has written the best poems for Bengalis of all ages and even for the entire world which needs a very sophisticated mind and a lot of literary sense to really enjoy them. Professor Debapriya Bhattacharya told us this essence at the beginning of the discussion.
